#### WWS – Annual Report for the year 2015 – 2016

The Principal and the College Council has decided to continue me as the Coordinator for the Higher Education's New Initiative programme Walk With a Scholar(WWS) this year also. After that the programme was notified and invited application on 01/09/2015 for the freshers. We have received the application till 18/09/2015. The selected students list for the year 2015-2016 was published on 22/09/2014. The Principal appointed 5 new Internal Mentors for the WWS program 2015-2016. They are Dr.Kishorekumar B S, Sri. Satyanarayanan S, Dr. Sajithkumar I V, Sri. Shaji N Raj and Smt. Spasiba Ravendran. I convened an initial meeting of WWS students and assigned 6 students for each mentors on 30/09/2015 according to the student's ambition. Our Principal officially Inaugurated the WWS programme on 05/10/2015.I convened various meetings of the WWS 2015-2016 batch to explain the program contents and seek their expectations from this program on 7/12/2015 and 6/1/2016. On 28/01/2016, we organized a meeting for the WWS students and their Parents to discuss the Programme features. The parents and the students became aware about this programme through this meeting. In that meeting, Principal distributed the stationary materials to students, Mentors and to the Coordinator. The **first** External Mentoring class for the 2015-2016 batch was on **30/01/2016** and it was handled by **Dr. Mary Matilda**. The topics were *Communication Skills, Barriers to effective communication and how to improve communication*. The feedback collected by the mentors from their mentees shows that the class was so Interesting, Informative and highly interactive. All the mentees unanimously said that they never get bored during the session and she was in close touch with every mentees all the time.

The **Second** External Mentoring class for the 2014-2015 batch was on **12/03/2016** and it was handled by *Sri.Arun Gladwin*. 


